

# **Bacteria Cloud Installation Guide**

 $\mbox{\bf Step 1}$  : The setup icon that appears after downloading the setup looks like the picture given below:




Figure 2: License Agreement

**Step 2**: By double clicking on Setup logo as shown above, window like Figure 2 will appear for the License agreement, click on "I accept the agreement" radio button and then press Next.

**Step 3**: The software automatically gets installed in the C:\.Bacteria\_Cloud folder.

Step 4: It now asks you where you want to create a desktop icon or not as shown in the figure.




Figure 3: It shows whether to create a desktop icon or not and on pressing next it installs the software in C:\Bacteria\_Cloud Folder
